



Rules for use of Parish Noticeboards

1. Priority for display will be given to:
 Notices required by the business of the Parish Council such as notifications of meetings and their agenda; statutory notices etc.
 Notices requested to be displayed by the County or district Councils or their agendas and other Government bodies.
2. Second priority will be given to notices on behalf of charitable institutions, particularly those based within the Parish or its environs for the purposes of advertising support services for parishioners' or fund-raising initiatives and events
3. Space permitting, advertisements will be accepted from small businesses based in the Parish or those bordering offering services to local people. Requests concerning lost domestic pets may also be accommodated but only from residents of the Parish.

Wherever possible notices should be A5 size or below.

If there is lack of space, category 3 posters will be removed in favour of the first two priority classes or will be substituted by other category 3 posters in one month.

Notices displayed other than on the parish noticeboards, such as on telegraph poles or roadside placards will be removed whatever the content.

The only exception to this is where notification of planning applications or alterations to rights of way may be required to be displayed outside of property boundaries.
